

UNAPPROVED

A public hearing was held on Tuesday, September 8th, 2026 at 5:30 pm at City Hall, 213 College Street, Pilot Grove, Mo. for the purpose of addressing citizen's comments relating to the Tax Levy for the year of 2026.

City Clerk, Lori Vollrath called the public hearing to order at 5:30 p.m.

City Clerk, Lori Vollrath asked everyone to sign the attendance sheet.

City Clerk, Lori Vollrath read the intentions of this public hearing: "The 2026 assessed valuation for both real estate and personal property of the City totals \$6,910,765 an increase of \$94,299 from the 2025 assessed valuation of \$6,816,466. The Missouri State Auditor has proposed the tax levy be set at 0.7663 cents per \$100 valuation, unchanged from last year. The Council will consider the proposed 2026 tax levy during the regular scheduled council meeting on Tuesday, September 8, 2026, at 6:00 pm at City Hall.

Seven individuals attended the hearing with no inquiries, comments or concerns made.

City Clerk, Lori Vollrath asked if anyone had any other questions or concerns. With no further questions or concerns the hearing was adjourned at 5:57 p.m.
